## 1. QUESTION: WHY DO YOU WANT TO BE PART OF THE EM FAIRNESS COMMITTEE?

- ☐ 1.5 points for specifying a basic/simple answer
- ☐ 2 points for specifying an average answer with no example/reasons
- ☐ 3 points for specifying a good/complete answer with one example/reason
- ☐ 3.5 points for specifying a very good answer with more than 2 examples/reasons
- ☐ 4 points for a fully complete answer with good reasons.
- ☐ 4.5 points for a perfect answer with a multitude of reasons.

## 2. QUESTION: DESCRIBE THE “PEOPLE’S CHOICE” SELECTION. HOW CAN IT BE IMPROVED? GIVE EXAMPLES.

- ☐ 0.5 points for a simple and unclear description with no other examples or ideas
- ☐ 1.5 points for a complete description without any ideas or examples
- ☐ 2 points for a complete description and relevant improvement ideas with no examples
- ☐ 3 points for a complete description and relevant improvement ideas with 1 – 2 examples
- ☐ 3.5 points for a complete description and relevant improvement ideas with 3 examples
- ☐ 4 points for a complete description and relevant improvements with more than 3 examples

## 3. QUESTION: RULE NO. 5.7 STATES THE FACT THAT: “THE FC WILL PROPOSE, VOTE AND APPLY NEW RULES”. WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS ABOUT THIS RULE? GIVE RELEVANT EXAMPLES TO SUPPORT YOUR ARGUMENT/S.

- ☐ 2 points for an unclear argument with no examples
- ☐ 2.5 points for a simple argument with a weak example
- ☐ 3.5 points for a well-structured argument with 1 or 2 relevant support examples
- ☐ 5 points for a well-structured argument with more than 2 relevant support examples

## 4. PROBLEM: BELARUS SUBMITTED A SONG WHICH WAS USED BY RUSSIA 17 EDITIONS AGO. IT QUALIFIED IN THE FINAL. THE FC FAILED TO DETECT THE ISSUE AND NOW ALMOST HALF OF THE EM PARTICIPANTS VOTED IN THE GRAND FINAL. WHAT CAN THE FC DO NOW? GIVE EXAMPLES TO SUPPORT YOUR ARGUMENTS.

- ☐ 1 point for an answer which is considered to be incorrect
- ☐ 2 points for specifying a correct and simple answer with no arguments.
- ☐ 3.5 points for a well-structured answer with no solid arguments.
- ☐ 4.5 points for a well-structured answer with less than 2 solid arguments
- ☐ 6.5 points for a well-structured answer with more than 2 solid support arguments.

### Problem Solution:

Since half of the EM members voted, Belarus will not be disqualified until everyone voted. At the end of the voting, Belarus will be **disqualified**. Since the player didn't know that Russia already used the song 17 editions ago, he or she is allowed to enter the next contest. If Belarus refuses to vote in the final due to the fact that it will be disqualified, then the player will not be allowed to enter the next edition.
